HOMELESS PREVENTION ACTIVITIES PROGRAM

Centennial Mental Health Center's Housing Department recently received notification that the Colorado Division of Housing has awarded Centennial, Homeless Prevention Activity funds to provide assistance to Centennial clients who are at imminent risk of becoming homeless. These funds will provide time limited financial assistance and case management services to eligible households who have a documented temporary economic crisis and are at imminent risk of homelessness.

These funds maybe used to assist households who meet the following criteria:

- The inability to make the required payments is due to a sudden reduction in income
- The assistance is necessary to avoid eviction or termination of assistance
- There is a reasonable prospect they will be able to resume payments within 6 months or less

Eligible financial assistance costs include the payment of rent and essential utilities for eligible households able to document a temporary economic crisis putting them at imminent risk of homelessness.
