### *Alysa Explains Genoa Med Services And Options:*

Genoa Healthcare has many things to offer. We have a Consumer medication coordinator (CMC) on site that can answer any and all questions about the pharmacy. We also have a pharmacy inside the Fort Morgan clinic that can send meds daily. As a CMC, we can keep your meds in our office for one less travel stop to pick up meds, you can get your meds sent via mail directly to your home, or our delivery driver can go directly to your house. We also have dispill packs, which makes taking your meds a little easier. The dispill packs can pack any of your daily medications for morning, noon, or night, so that you don't have to worry about shifting through a bunch of vials. We also offer vials and bubble packs. As the CMC, I make reminder calls when it is almost time for your meds to be refilled, and I can help with enrollment paperwork. I can also connect you directly to the pharmacy if you have any questions. We can fill all daily meds, not just meds from this clinic, but also from your primary care doctors. Genoa can also fill meds for your families, not just you. We strive to help make your lives easier with taking your meds.
