25% capacity or 25 people



Restaurants

25% capacity or 50 people
6ft between parties
outdoors, per local zoning



Indoor Events

25 person cap (with calculator)



Offices

25% capacity



Outdoor Events

75 person cap (with calculator)

Closed



Senior Facilities

Closed except for compassionate visitation




Gyms/Fitness

Virtual, or outdoors in groups less than 10

25% capacity or 10 people
