
fast, abstain from pleasures and pray to become closer to God. It is also a time for families to gather and celebrate.

Firearm-related suicides have increased in our area in recent months and, while safe storage and limiting access to lethal means for suicidal persons is always an important issue, it is particularly salient right now. Providing people with free firearm cable locks also
