This will all be included in the Briefing for December 13th!!

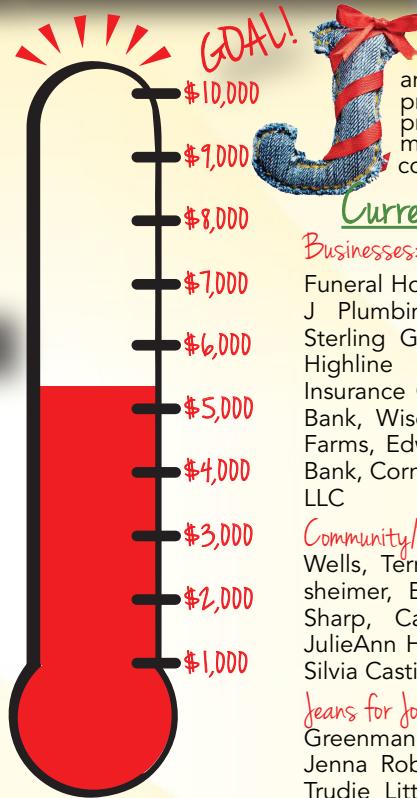
