MEDS ONLY SERVICES

To dispel some myths regarding meds only clients.

Any client that meets one of these criteria, as determined by the clinician and approved by the med provider, can be meds only with Centennial:

- 1) Client is a nursing home resident that has been deemed not appropriate for therapy by a PASRR evaluation.
- 2) Client is from a Developmentally Disable Agency and will not benefit from therapy.
- 3) Client is eligible for Medicaid and engaging in therapy with a community therapist.
- 4) Client is new to the area, stable and taking medications prescribed by a previous prescriber.
- 5) Client is at maximum benefit and stable, having completed OP therapy.

The only criteria where the guarantor has any bearing, is #3.

Numbers 1, 2, 4 and 5 can be Medicaid, Medicare, Private Insurance, etc.
