



Mandatory Disclosure Statement

The practice of licensed or registered persons in the field of psychotherapy is regulated by the Mental Health Licensing Section of the Divisions of Registrations. The Board of Examiners can be reached at 1560 Broadway, Suite 1350, Denver, CO, 80202 or at (303) 894-7800.

Regulatory requirements application to mental health professionals:

1. Centennial Mental Health Center, 211 W. Main St, Sterling, CO, 80751. (970) 522-4392.
 - The information provided by and to the client during therapy sessions is legally confidential and cannot be released without the client consent or a Judge signed Court Order. There are exceptions to this confidentiality, which are listed in section 12.42.128 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, as well as other exceptions in Colorado and Federal law. For example, mental health professionals are required to report suspected child abuse and/or neglect, elderly or disabled adults at risk for abuse and/or neglect, or if you present as a danger to yourself or others, to appropriate entities.
 - An Unlicensed Psychotherapist is a psychotherapist listed in the State's database and is authorized by law to practice psychotherapy in Colorado, but is not licensed by the state and is not required to satisfy any standardized educational or testing requirements to obtain registration from the state.
 - A Certified Addiction Technician (CAT/ACA) must be a high school graduate or equivalent, complete required training hours, 1,000 hours of supervised experience and pass the NAADAC NCAC Level I exam.
 - A Certified Addiction Specialist (CAS/ACC) must have a bachelor's degree in clinical behavior health, complete required training hours, 3,000 of supervised experience (may include hours completed for the CAT/ACA), and pass the NAADAC NCAC Level II exam.
 - A Licensed Addiction Counselor (LAC/ACD) must have a clinical master's degree, meet the CAS/ACC requirements OR complete 2,000 additional hours of supervised experience, and pass the NAADAC MAC exam.
 - A Licensed Social Worker must hold a master's degree from a graduate school of social work and pass an examination in social work.
 - A Psychologist Candidate, a Marriage and Family Therapist Candidate, and a Licensed Professional Counselor Candidate must hold the necessary licensing degree and be in the process of completing the required supervision for licensure.

- A Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist must hold a master's or doctoral degree in marriage and family counseling, have at least two years post-master's or one-year post-doctoral practice, and pass an exam in marriage and family therapy.
 - A Licensed Professional Counselor must hold a master's or doctoral degree in professional counseling, have at least two years post-master's or one-year post-doctoral practice, and pass an exam in professional counseling.
 - A Licensed Psychologist must hold a doctorate degree in psychology, have one year of post-doctoral supervision, and pass an examination in psychology.
2. A client may make a complaint at any time during the therapy process. They may contact Centennial Mental Health Center's Client Advocate to make an initial complaint. They may also contact Northeast Health Partners at 9925 Federal Drive, Suite 100, Colorado Springs, CO, 80921, (800) 221-3943 (State Relay 711) and Colorado Access, PO Box 17950, Denver, CO, 80217, (844) 880-8508.
 3. The practice of licensed or unlicensed persons in the field of psychotherapy is regulated by the Mental Health Licensing Section of the Division of Professions and Occupations. The Department of Regulatory Agencies can be reached at 1560 Broadway, Denver, CO, 80202.
 4. As a client you are entitled to receive information about the methods of therapy, the techniques used, the duration of therapy, if known, and the fee structure.
 5. A client may seek a second opinion from another therapist or may terminate therapy at any time.
 6. In a professional relationship, sexual intimacy is never appropriate and should be reported to the Department of Regulatory Agencies.
 7. If your clinician is an unlicensed psychotherapist they are not required to satisfy any standardized educational or testing requirements to obtain registration from the state.
